Great Plains Lutheran High School is a private school providing top-quality education to 130 secondary students in grades 9-12. Located in a small town in the American Midwest, GPLHS offers an ideal combination of a clean, quiet, and safe study environment, together with an authentic American cultural experience.

Application Procedure & Cost

Step One: Online Application

Fill out an international application at www.gplhs.org/international-students, and submit a US\$150 application fee.

Step Two: Upload Documents

GPLHS will contact the agent/student to confirm receipt of application and arrange a Skype interview and/or writing sample.

Step Three: Enrollment Fee

After the interview, an admission decision will be sent via e-mail. Further instructions will be sent, and a \$2000 enrollment fee will reserve a place at GPLHS.

Step Four: I-20 Form

Upon receipt of the enrollment fee, the I-20 form (necessary for the visa application) will be sent from GPLHS. The student's academic schedule will also be made.

• Step Five: Visa Application

Follow instructions received from GPLHS and the US Embassy in your home country to apply for an F-1 student visa. Visit www.ice.gov/sevis to pay the \$350 SEVIS fee. Everything should be submitted in time for our mid-August intake.

♦ Total Cost: US\$22,700 per year

(Health insurance is required but not included in this cost.)
