

## Frequently Asked Questions:

- What should I bring?
  - Checking Account or Cash Card or some method or ability to purchase unexpected items
  - Insurance Card, Prescription Card & Prescriptions
  - Over-the-counter Remedies for Cold, Cough, etc.
  - Phone Card (Long distance calls cannot be made from the dorm without one)
  - Stamps and Envelopes
  - Bedding: Mattress Pad & Bed Linens (Most mattresses are standard twin size, a few extra-long are available and can be requested), Pillows and Blankets
  - Towels and Washcloths
  - Tissues (several boxes)
  - Command Strips, if you wish, to hang decorating items on the walls.
  - Plates, spoons, forks, drinking glass, mug for use in the Canteen; Dish Soap, wash rag & towel. Remember it is your responsibility to clean your items.
  - Laundry Detergent and Fabric Softener
  - Toilet Paper
  - Garbage bags (small, kitchen size)
  - Cleaning Supplies for Shower, Toilet Bowl, and Windows as well as Rags and Dusting Spray
- What are the expectations for behavior?
  - We have confidence that you and each dormitory resident will lead a life that reflects your love of God. We trust that your Savior's example will guide you in your conduct while here, and that his love for you will motivate you to live in respect and love for those around you.
- What happens if I am sick? Can I call my parents?
  - Each school day morning – if you are sick you should check in (in person) with the dormitory staff member on duty between 7:00 – 7:30 a.m. Parents will be notified by email the day a student misses school due to illness.
- Do I have access to a refrigerator, microwave and/or TV?
  - There is a refrigerator and microwave available for use in the canteen (be sure to label food items).
  - You can have a refrigerator in your dorm room. You would provide the refrigerator. There is a fee of \$35 per semester to cover the extra electricity use.
  - There is access to various TVs throughout the dorm
    - 2 Cable ready TVs in the lounge areas
    - 3 Video gaming TVs throughout the dormitory
    - 1 Movie room with large screen projector
- What if I don't like what's served for supper?
  - You should take the food at supper that you will eat. There is a canteen area available where you can prepare a snack at other times during the evening.
- Are there any food items that are not allowed in the dormitory for allergy reasons?
  - This can vary on a year to year basis. Please check with the housing supervisor at the start of the school year.
- How are roommates selected? Do I get to pick my roommate?
  - Returning Freshman, Sophomores and Juniors select their roommates at the end of the current school year.
  - The Dean of Students, the President and the Dormitory Staff consult with each other to pair up new students.

- Do I have to follow a bedtime?
  - On weekdays grades 9-10 are in bed with lights out at 10:15
  - On weekdays grades 11 -12 are in bed with lights out at 10:45
  - On weekends all students are in their room at 11:30 with lights out at 12:30
- How much money should I bring?
  - It is best to have a small amount of carry-around cash and access to a checking card to obtain more cash when necessary
- How should I secure my valuables (electronics)?
  - Your valuables should be put away in your dorm room and you should lock your door when you leave.
  - Large amounts of money should be given to the housing supervisor to hold for you
