



Admissions Criteria

Standards for Evaluating Prospective Students

A. Spiritual Considerations

- Willingness of parents and student to be supportive of the school's mission and philosophy of education.
- Willingness of parents and student to support the administration and faculty in carrying out the goals and programs of the school.

B. Behavioral Considerations

- History of acceptable citizenship in previous school experience.
- Agreement of student to abide by the behavior standards established by the school.

C. Academic Considerations

- Documented record of acceptable grades and achievement test scores in previous school experience.
- Ability of Great Plains Lutheran High School to meet the academic needs of the student.

D. Personal Considerations

- Ability of Great Plains Lutheran High School to meet any special needs of the student.
- Great Plains Lutheran High School makes no distinction in its admission policy on the basis of race, color, or national and ethnic origin.
