



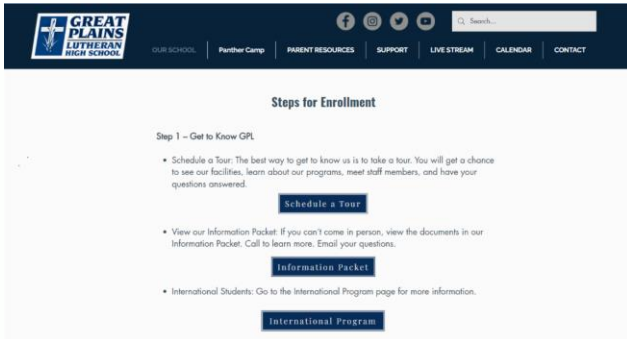

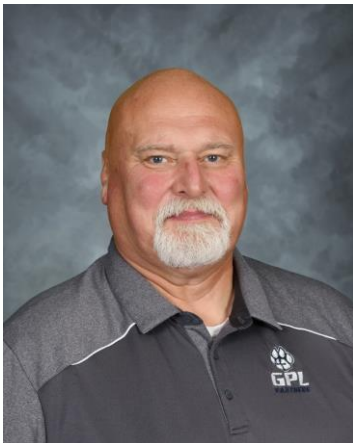
Recap of the GSI Thrift Annual Meeting
